He has secured more than \$30,000.00 in donations, grants and corporate matching funds. He has chosen a designer and builder. He also has secured in-kind donations of lumber, round steel tubing, steel fabrication, soil and reduced-cost rear, concrete and stone. The skate park will be 5,000 square feet, all concrete, to be constructed in Rhinehart Park in Winamac. Plan on starting the project at the end of June and completion of 1/3 of the proposed skate park to be July 20 to satisfy the requirements of the Eagle Scout project. The remainder of Phase 1 will be in August. The completion of Phase 2 will depend upon the success of my fundraising. I am requesting two things, a letter of support from the Council and any funding that ca be afforded. Jerry Sullivan did agree to do a letter of support from the Council.
