IN RE: MINUTES APPROVED

The County Council approved the minutes for the February 10, 2014 at their regular meeting and Joint Session on February 10, 2014. Motion made by Thomas J. Roth, seconded by Michael D. (Mick) Tiede. Motion carried.

IN RE: DRAINAGE BOARD

Comes now, Jenny Keller, Surveyor, This was brought before and I have 2 extra claims, our attorney at the time Daniel Tankersley had extra issues and went over and beyond and should be paid, it totals \$1,200.00. The Fell/Taylor and Starke County is in charge they are trying to assess Pulaski County and we have no maintenance fund to pay this. Also Wuethrich/Lowry issue and we have no maintenance fund for that.

IN RE: MAINTENANCE BUIDLING ISSUES

Comes now, Jeff Johnston, Director, has issues with the roof at the Justice Center. The roof is being fixed right now. It cost lots of money. The elevator in the Courthouse went out, the parts are obsolete, can find parts anywhere in three states. We are working on the elevator at the annex center. You were gracious enough to allow me a budget for repairs; if I keep using it to fix this stuff I won't have a budget. The Council is asking that you privatize what needs to be done and do first. Is there other funds to tackle into to help pay for this stuff. Jerry Sullivan is asking for paperwork showing what you are spending on these projects and what the costs are. Not to prepare a wish list, but a list of projects you are working on right now, would like to see.

Is there going to be a fund set up for the ADA projects? Am I supposed to pay this out of my budget or what are we to pay these things from.

IN RE: WEST SIDE PROJECTS

Comes now, Nathan Origer, CDC Director – West side property update I have spoken to the engineer and they should be ready by the end of this month. When they tell me that the 2(two) properties are ready they will let me know.

I am here for the Town of Monterey's and there Engineer. They are budgeted for what they would need to do the waste water project. They budgeted the match \$20,000.00, then the state changed some things and now they need another \$20,000.00. The Major Concervence did agree to donate 10,000.00 They still will need \$10,000.00 to finish the project. So the Commissioners agreed to help with the funding pending County Council approval? Jerry Sullivan commented that the county hadn't helped out Star City with their Sewer or any other town so doesn't seem fair if we help them. Could we do a loan to Monterey at a cheaper interest rate?

The proposals are due at the end of the week. So I need to know what you might do. Motion made by Roger Querry to allot \$10,000.00 for Monterey on their terms by May. Seconded by Ronald Powers. Motion carried.

IN RE: CONTROL POD UPDATE

Comes now, Sheriff Mike Gayer, to upgrading our control pod, it's a round room the controls the whole jail. It has not been upgrades since the jail was built.

On another issue Sheriff's department refuses to turn in time cards and we want them term in. By you not clocking in it puts a present for other departments.

Comes now, Ed Clark Manager, the backhoe is excellent. Do you have an idea what the concrete is going to cost? Discussed the issue with sorting the Town of Winamac Recycling's and whether they will continue doing this or not. We don't have a contract yet. Motion made by Douglas Roth to approve the purchase of the Grapple at \$1,257.00, seconded by Ronald Powers. Motion Carried.

**ORDINANCE 2014-01
JOINT ORDINANCE ON SPEED LIMIT
ON COUNTY ROAD 950 SOUTH**

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council have the power to regulate traffic on any highway in the county highway system under the authority of I.C. 8-17-1-40, I.C. 9-21 and pursuant to the Joint Ordinance enacted on August 22, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners and Pulaski county Council have determined that the speed limit on County Road 950 South lying West of 700 West shall be 30 mph ; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County council that after the erection of an appropriate speed limit sign that conforms to the state manual and specifications showing a 30 mile per hour limit.

Violation: Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction, and may be fined accordingly.

Effective Date: This ordnance shall be in full force and effect on passing by the Pulaski County board of Commissioners and Pulaski County Council, and the posting of proper signs, giving notice of the traffic regulation, and the required publication has been completed in the accordance with Indiana law.
