IN RE: HIGHWAY VOTE

IN RE: ADDITIONAL FOR DRAINAGE BOARD ATTORNEY

Commissioners are asking for an additional appropriation for the Drainage Board Attorney. The Drainage Board Attorney has to deal with other issues beside his normal duties on the drainage board. IC Code is 36-9-27-73 addresses the approved uses for General Drain Improvements. We still have an outstanding bill of \$3,600.00 that is still owed to Alan Hizer, Attorney at Law. Timothy Murray is the drainage board attorney now. Wish we could have taken the amount out of the appropriate ditch.

IN RE: COMP TIME – 20 HOURS

IN RE: RECYCLING

Jeff Bonnell, Manager at Recycling/Transfer Station talked with Larry L. Jay said, have him get the information and present it to all of us, so we all can be a part of it.

IN RE: COUNTY HOME RESIDENT RENT

Regarding the rent, how do we have them pay their rent for the month, because some of them are finding placement so we're not sure how long they will be there, if they pay their rent, we can reimburse them overpayment of the rent they paid and was not used. We are to consult the attorney that has been hired to handle these issues. Jay said he has been in contacted with the attorney Jere Humphrey for the county home.
