ORDINANCE 02-2015

JOINT ORDINANCE ON SPEED LIMIT ON COUNTY ROAD EAST 50 SOUTH

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council have the power to regulate traffic on any highway in the county highway system under the authority of I.C. 8-17-1-40, I.C. 9-21 and pursuant to the Joint Ordinance enacted on August 22, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners and Pulaski County Council have determined that the speed limit on County Road East 50 South lying between the junction of South Old State Road 14 and County Road East 50 South to the junction of County Road East 50 South and East 200 South shall be 30 mph ; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council that after the erection of an appropriate speed limit sign that conforms to the state manual and specifications showing a 30 mile per hour limit.

Violation: Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction, and may be fined accordingly.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on passing by the Pulaski County Board of Commissioners and Pulaski County Council, and the posting of proper signs, giving notice of the traffic regulation, and the required publication has been completed in the accordance with Indiana law.
