

The Pulaski County Council met in regular session on May 11, 2015 in the Commissioners Room at the Courthouse in Winamac, Indiana, at 7:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time. Meeting was called to order by Jerry Sullivan, President, also present were: Roger Querry, Vice-President, Michael T. Tiede, Douglas Roth, Thomas J. Roth, Alexsondra Haschel, Linda Powers, Shelia K. Garling, Auditor.

**IN RE: MINUTES APPROVED**

The County Council approved the Council minutes for the April 13, 2015 meeting was approved as submitted upon a motion made by Michael T. Tiede, seconded by Alexsondra Haschel. Motion carried.

**IN RE: DLGF – PHASE III**

Comes now, Holly VanDerAa, Assessor to updates you, I am asking for a transfer because I'm putting another layer on with WTH, it's being paid for all from Reassessment. Phase III test has been done by the DLGF and the Assessor's office and the Auditor's office passed.

**IN RE: HIGHWAY TRANSFER**

Comes now, Terry Ruff, Highway Superintendent needing to advertise for the seasonal temporary help, I have someone already in mind but I want the part time rate changed from \$12.90 to \$16.05, at a higher rate. A Council member commented we can't keep changing the salary ordinance hourly rate every time we have a change. Terry Ruff said, he will need to transfer money so I can pay a part time person because there isn't enough to pay someone.

**IN RE: EMS RATES**

Comes now, Nikki Lowry, EMS Director to discuss how the pay is, when working 24 hours and taking 24 hours off. They are short the 12 hours because of the overtime that's already calculated. As of right now they receive 48 hours of PTO, they would like it to be put at 72 hours so there check won't be shorted when they take time off.

Lengthy discussion was done regarding the increase that was being asked for in wages so they might be able to hire new people and keep the employees they have. Motion made by Thomas J. Roth to approve the committee proposal and \$102,000.00 for EMS wages, seconded by Michael T. Tiede. Motion carried.

**IN RE: BUILDING INSPECTOR UNUSED PLANNING COMMISSION/BZA MONEY**

Comes now, Dave Dare, Building Inspector to request that the money not being used in the budget for Planning Commission and the BZA board for part time be giving to Dave Weber for all the work he does. No motion was made, so the request died.

**IN RE: LOAN TO MONTEREY**

Comes now, Nathan Origer, CDC Director and Jim Fluery, Monterey Town Board. The Town of Monterey is requesting a loan form the county, which is more than previous requested. The total cost of the project is going to be at \$275,000.00. The increase requested amount is \$15,000.00 for a total of \$35,000.00 that the county would loan to Monterey.

**IN RE: WHEEL TAX**

Comes now, Patrick Conner, IN LTAP, LOHUT (Local Option Highway User Tax) to discuss the having Wheel tax. Wheel Tax is a tax per plated vehicle, not a tax per wheel. This money can only be used for county, city, or town may only use the surtax revenues it receives under to construct, reconstruct, repair, or maintain streets and roads under its jurisdiction.
