

The Pulaski County Board of Commissioners convened in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. Eastern Time in the Commissioner's Room, at the Courthouse in Winamac, Indiana, the call to order by Larry L. Brady, President upon the Pledge of Allegiance the meeting began. Present also were Terry L. Young, Vice-President, Bud Krohn, Jr., Commissioners, Kevin Tankersley, County Attorney and Shelia K. Garling, Auditor.

IN RE: PAYROLL & OTHER CLAIMS AND ALLOWANCES

Comes now, Brad Zellers, Manager of Town of Winamac to inquire about tearing down the Long Branch Property and if the County would help. Larry Brady said to get in touch with Terry Ruff, Superintendent of County Highway and see what can be worked out. Motion made by Terry L. Young, to proceed, seconded by Bud Krohn, Jr. Motion carried. Get in touch with Brad Bonnell, Manager Recycling/Transfer Station. The outlook of the property is to level it and put grass on it.

IN RE: EMS REPORT

Comes now, Nikki Lowry, EMA Director to give her monthly report. How are the ambulance, the 4th one is up and running. The new billing software is a little difficult and we are learning. In the month of November we had 153 calls, 50 were transfers, and 12 were outside agencies for ASL transfers. We have been very busy, critical calls. We had our final safety meeting for this year. Reports were given; Nikki thinks it is a benefit to have this committee.

IN RE: ORDINANCE MOBILITY HANDYCAP

Comes now, Robert Rothenberger, regarding a Ordinance for an Mobility Handicap vehicle, So we could use an handicap vehicle on the county roads. Kevin Tankersley pointed out that the ordinance from another county reverts back to an IC code that doesn't allow certain things. This also could be an issue with the Sheriff's deputy trying to monitor this or enforcing it. Terry Young Made a motion to Table this.

IN RE: RECYCLING/TRANSFER STATION

Comes now, Brad Bonnell, Manager to give his monthly report. Is using a credit card machine and it is working quite well. The plastic fell out, no one is picking up. Just for the time being. Give report on cardboard, getting about \$90.00 a ton. Expenses were up, because of some purchases. The refurbished truck should be here in about 2 weeks.

Wants to make the retaining wall bigger at the Transfer station on the east side.

IN RE: SHERIFF'S REPORT

Comes now, Jeff Richwine, Sheriff to request a change of hours 9:30 - 5:30 Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday for the Matron (Carrie Aaron). Motion made by Terry L. Young to change the hours. Seconded by Bud Krohn, Jr. Motion carried. Received a check for the plumbing in the jail where we will be able to control the water usage. Securities Company has offered to pay all expenses for 4 people from the Jail to go to Dallas TX for training. It will be the 1st week or 2nd week of February. Motion made by Terry Young, seconded by Bud Krohn, Motion carried.

Trying to get the lighting fixed in the jail. Some of the issues were taken care of by the Justice Center. The locks are an issue they are 20 years old and we are working on that.

The Sheriff said he has no issues with the off road vehicles. I checked with DNR. The Conservationist Officer's do enforce it, they will write tickets.

Changing the hours for Lessa Gayers to match the policy book, of 6:00 am to 2:00 pm. Will take place January 1, 2016. We are thinking about changing some of the things in the kitchen. I think we could save some money in the kitchen by having a source that would prepare the food and all we would have to do was heat them and serve. By doing this we may not need a full time cook. It would be a 14 day rotation and cost about \$1.05 a meal.

The Sheriff is still working on getting titles for the military vehicles, a total of 10 we still haven't received.

Terry L. Young, with concerns with the Medaryville Library closing, hoping that all parties can come together and work this out. Terry L. Young complements Susan Bergens on the letter she wrote.
