WHEREAS THE COUNTY COUNCIL HAS, ON THE THIRTEENTH DAY OF June, 2011 approved the following described areas as an Economic Revitalization Area:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Part of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 30 North, Range 4 West, Bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the East line of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said section *** which point is 58 feet North of the Southeast corner of said quarter quarter section; thence westerly parallel with the South line of said quarter quarter section 250 to the East line of the right of way of the CSX Railroad (formerly Louisville and Nashville Railroad and formerly Monon Railroad); thence Northerly along said right of way line 872 feet; thence Easterly parallel with the South line of said quarter quarter section 250 feet to the East line thereof thence South along said East line 872 feet to the point of beginning; containing 5 acres, more or less; subject to all roadways.

For a Period of 10 years, and

WHEREAS this Economic Revitalization Area allows partial abatement of property taxes attributable to redevelopment or rehabilitation activities and the installation of new manufacturing equipment activities under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-4.5, and

WHEREAS the property owner has requested property tax abatement for new equipment as evidenced by exhibit "A", form SB-1, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof this Resolution, and

WHEREAS all evidence and testimony concerning this application for Tax Abatement was considered by the Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Council has reviewed the application for Tax Abatement and attached statements of benefits and finds that all requirements have been met and that the estimate of the value, number of employees, and the annual salaries describe therein are reasonable for the described projects.
2. The Council finds that the totality of the benefits described for the projects are sufficient to justify tax abatement in the designated area for a period of ten years.
3. The Council, having made its findings in the affirmative, hereby approves property tax abatement for Fratco, Inc., for new manufacturing equipment, all as described on the attached form SB-1, for a period of ten years for the described project.
4. A copy of this resolution shall be filed with the County Assessor.
