Eastern Daylight Time in the Commissioners room in the Courthouse, said meeting was called to order, then upon the Pledge of Allegiance the meeting began. **IN RE: SECURITY**

Comes now, Sheriff Richwine commented that the Commissioners had approved the 911 contract. Sheriff Richwine and Christi Hoffa, Clerk to bring the need for Security in the Courthouse.

Christi Hoffa commended that the same people that deal with the courts also interact with her office. She said the Justice Center offices have security that the courthouse doesn't have. Her office only has one panic button and in the past has not been answered in a timely matter. It's not just angry taxpayers coming in, it's angry criminals, felons. Something needs done.

Sheriff Richwine agrees the Courthouse security needs to be addressed. He suggested that a single-point entry may be the best option. But it would need to be man by two officers, it would be a full time position. Sheriff Richwine suggested some other options that may help.

Judge Shurn talked about the plan that he had started back in 2013, and the committee that he chooses back them will still serve. Judge Shurn suggested some option and gave examples of situations. Linda Powers commented that we are trying to figure out how we are going to pay for everything and prioritize. Jerry Sullivan commented that the security committee needs to be considered in conjunction with the Americans with Disabilities Act regulations.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:47 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, motion made by Roger Querry, seconded by Thomas J. Roth, motion carried County Council. Motion made by Terry L. Young, seconded by Bud Krohn, Jr. Motion carried. County Commissioners.
