REGULAR SESSION

COUNTY COUNCIL

The Pulaski County Council met in special session on March 12, 2018 at the County Highway Garage Training Room in Winamac, Indiana, at 7:00pm EDST. Those present were Jerry (Jay) Sullivan, Mike Tiede, Thomas J. Roth, Kenneth Boswell, Scott Hinkle, Linda Powers, and Auditor Laura Wheeler. Alexsondra Haschel was absent.

Also present were: Amber Tomlinson, Michael Gallenberger of WKVI, Jerry Locke, Kenny Becker, Judge Shurn, Jeff Johnston, JoLynn Johnston, Brian Young, Jeff Richwine.

IN RE: CIRCUIT COURT

Judge Shurn explained the start of the security committee in 2013 terminated at the point of discussion of a Courthouse expansion. When the new administration dismissed the Courthouse expansion, the security committee reconvened in March 2017. Security is not only protecting against guns but also educating on reactions and safety. It is not only for the Courts and Justice Center but also for high profile areas such as the County Clerk's office and the Assessor's office. Judge Shurn asked if any Council member would like to serve on this committee. Kenneth Boswell volunteered if meetings could be limited to Mondays prior to the Council meetings.

Scott Hinkle motioned to appoint Kenneth Boswell to serve on the Security Committee and Linda Powers seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
