ORDINANCE 2019-2

JOINT ORDINANCE ON SPEED LIMIT ON COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council have the power to regulate traffic on any highway in the county highway system under the authority of IC 8-17-1-40, IC 9-21 and pursuant to the Joint Ordinance enacted on August 22, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners and Pulaski County Council have determined that the speed limit on County Road 150 South lying west of U.S. 35 and east of State Road 119 (commonly referred to as Tee Pak road) shall be 35mph; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council that after the erection of an appropriate speed limit sign that conforms to the state manual and specifications showing 35 miles per hour limit that the speed limit on County Road 150 South lying west of U.S. 35 and east of State Road 119 to be 35 mph (commonly referred to as Tee Pak road).

Violation: Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction and may be fined accordingly.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on passing by the Pulaski County Board of Commissions and Pulaski County Council, and the posting of proper signs, giving notice of the traffic regulation, and the required publication has been completed in the accordance with Indian law.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County on this 11th day of February 2019 and the Pulaski County Council on the 11th day of February 2019.
