The Pulaski County Council met in regular session Tuesday, November 12, 2019 at 7:00pm at the Pulaski County Highway Garage training room. Council members present were Jerry Sullivan, Michael Tiede, Scott Hinkle, Ron DeSabatine, Brian Young, Kathleen Thompson with Auditor Laura Wheeler. Ken Boswell was present by phone.

Dr. Cadwell explained the many services offered by Four County Counseling including a clinic at Braun Corporation, embedded services at West Central and Eastern Pulaski schools, their partnership with Pulaski Memorial for their Senior programs, and work with the Veterans' Court.
