REGULAR SESSION

PULASKI COUNTY COUNCIL

The Pulaski County Council met in regular session December 9, 2019 7:00PM at the Pulaski County Highway Department training room. Council members present were Jay Sullivan, Mike Tiede, Brian Young, Ken Boswell, Ron DeSabatine, Kathi Thompson and Auditor Laura Wheeler. Scott Hinkle was absent.

Also present were Nathan Origer, Jack Cooper, Michael Gallenberger, Brandon DeLorenzo, Judge Crystal Kocher, Sheriff Jeff Richwine, Judge Mary Welker.

President Jerry Sullivan opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**IN RE: EMS**

Pay for training class instructors discussed. Paramedics and Basic EMT staff get paid wages per the County MATRIX for instructing the same classes. EMS director, Brandon DeLorenzo wants the instructors to get the same amount for instructional duties. Paying instructors as contractors is considered and DeLorenzo plans to meet with County Attorney Kevin Tankersley to discuss the issues.

Judge Crystal Kocher requested a transfer of \$2,520.83 from Pauper Counsel to Examination of Prisoners. This is needed in order to cover a competency evaluation bill. **IN RE: MINUTES**

Minutes from September 30, 2019 and October 21, 2019 Special Session meetings; October 14, 2019 and November 12, 2019 Regular Session meetings were presented for approval. Brian Young requested a correction to the September 30, 2019 minutes by amending "CDC Secretary" to "CDC Project Coordinator" since there was never a secretary position.

Kathi Thompson made a motion to approve all minutes with the following modification: On the October 21, 2019 Special Session minutes, replace "Darrin Bates of Data Pit Stop who works with 62 other counties in Indiana has done a LIT analysis on Pulaski County data. By using a spreadsheet, Bates showed the effect of the proposed ordinance and suggested a few other configuration possibilities." with "A Pulaski County vendor, Darrin Bates of Data Pit Stop, who works with 62 other counties and moving data from one software system to another, shared that with at least 2 council members and the auditor, perhaps 3 or 4 and at some point he was invited to attend a Council meeting where he, using a County computer, was allowed to upend the conversation taking place with a true financial consultant, one whom was paid tens of thousands of dollars by this County, in order to sabotage the tax discussion." Kathi also included Brian Young's modification request in her motion. Ken Boswell seconded the motion. Motion was tied with Kathi Thompson, Brian Young and Ken Boswell in favor and Ron DeSabatine, Mike Tiede and Jerry Sullivan opposed. Brian Young then made a motion to approve all minutes except October 21, 2019 and with the September 30, 2019 modification as requested by Brian Young. Mike Tiede seconded and motion carried.
