

PULASKI COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRESS RELEASE

The Pulaski County Commissioners, by their President, Kenneth Becker, have extended the Executive Order of March 16, 2020 and the Temporary Work Force Reduction Policy until April 20, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. This order and policy DO NOT stop the operations of County services. All essential departments (Sheriff's Department, EMS, Health Department, and EMA) are functioning with a full staff. All other departments are available to the public to conduct necessary business. The physical locations of the departments are closed to normal ingress and egress, but you may still have a face-to-face meeting with any department you need by appointment. The entire workforce of the county is being compensated during this work force reduction, and, therefore, will do their best to accommodate the public while maintaining all safety and social distancing protocols provided by the Pulaski County Health Department. The Pulaski County Commissioners understand this may cause some delays in service and inconvenience to the public, and for this we apologize. It is, however, our main concern to control the spread of the COVID-19 virus in our community and to be part of the solution to this pandemic.
