REGULAR SESSION

PULASKI COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Pulaski County Commissioners met in regular session May 4, 2020 6:00PM at the Pulaski County Highway Department training room. Commissioners present were Ken Becker, Jerry Locke, Mike McClure, Auditor Laura Wheeler, and County Attorney Kevin Tankersley.

Also present were Nathan Origer, Kyle Hurd, Amber Thomlinson, and Jeff Richwine.

President Ken Becker opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

IN RE: PURCHASE COUNTY PROPERTY

Crestview subdivision lots discussed briefly. Sarah Grcich is interested in purchasing land in this area but research showed this was actually a roadway and cannot be sold.

IN RE: EMS

EMS is eligible to receive approximately \$18,000.00 of stimulus money from the CARES Act with restricted use. What is not used has to be sent back. Ken Becker made a motion to accept stimulus money, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.

IN RE: SHERIFF

Sheriff Jeff Richwine reported that he has used Charger parts and requested permission to donate them to the Logansport Police Department. Ken Becker made a motion giving permission to donate the used parts, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried.

IN RE: OTHER BUSINESS

Jerry Locke made a motion to approve April 06, 2020 and April 20, 2020 regular session minutes as presented, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Kenny Becker made a motion to approve Claims and Payroll as presented, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried unanimously.

No change to the Workforce Reduction announced at this time; however, Kenny Becker stated that with restaurants opening up May 11 at 50% capacity, public needs to use good judgement.

Nathan Origer needs approval to submit an application for grant funding for small business relief and no local match requirement. Mike McClure made a motion to approve submission of the application, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.

The County Highway presented the Annual Operational Report for Local Roads and Streets and Bridges for approval. Kenny Becker motioned to approve as presented, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Copier quotes from Advanced Imaging Solutions, CPI (formerly Copiers Plus, Inc.) and Cardinal Copier Solutions were discussed briefly. Ken Becker made a motion to table a decision until the lease agreements were reviewed by County Attorney, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.
