**REGULAR SESSION**

**PULASKI COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

The Pulaski County Commissioners met in regular session Monday November 2, 2020, 6:00 PM at the Pulaski County Highway Garage training room. Commissioners present were Ken Becker, Jerry Locke, Mike McClure with County Auditor Laura Wheeler and County Attorney Kevin Tankersley.

Also present were Connie Ehrlich, Donald Ehrlich, Michael Gallenberger, Sara Kroft, Audrey Kroft, Courtney Poor, John Masterson, Maurice Loehmer, Joe Moyer, Gail Lambert, Nathan Origer, Jeff Richwine and Judge Mary Welker.

President Ken Becker opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**IN RE: CDC**

Nathan Origer presented an agreement with Marketing Partnership International to outsource CDC's tourism marketing. Marketing Partnership will negotiate the best deals for the county in advertising tourism with their fees paid through commission from the different networks in the first year. The CDC board has approved the contract for a one-year trial. Mike McClure made a motion to approve the agreement as presented, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.

**IN RE: SHERIFF**

Jeff Richwine presented a new telephone agreement with Level 365 for approval. Roeing Corp, the County's Information Technology Group has been involved in this process. Mike McClure made a motion to approve the Level 365 agreement as presented, Ken Becker seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Discussion pursued on selling a specific rifle to a deputy leaving Pulaski County employment to work for Cass County. Mike McClure made a motion to approve the sale of the rifle, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.

The Animal Control position is now vacant and will be advertised.

**IN RE: CASA GRANT**

Sara Kroft presented the CASA Grant application for approval. Circuit Court budgets 40,000.00 for the CASA program and expects to receive two grants with this application for \$6,685.00 and \$2,866.00. Ken Becker made a motion to approve and sign the grant application, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried unanimously.

**IN RE: OTHER BUSINESS**

Jerry Locke made a motion to approve payroll and claims as presented, Mike McClure seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Jerry Locke made a motion to approve and sign the October 19, 2020 regular session meeting minutes as presented, Ken Becker seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Ken Becker announced that the Court House is closed Tuesday November 3 for election and Wednesday November 11 for Veteran's Day.

An agreement and Power of Attorney (POA) with MALCON for the preparation of fuel tax claims and refunds presented for approval. Mike McClure made a motion to approve and sign the agreement as presented, Jerry Locke seconded and motion carried unanimously.

An agreement to renew the Extension Contractual Services between Purdue University and the Government of Pulaski County, Indiana, with a cost of \$61,125.00 presented for approval and signatures. Jerry Locke made a motion to approve and sign the agreement as presented, Ken Becker seconded and motion carried unanimously.
