REGULAR SESSION

PULASKI COUNTY COUNCIL

The Pulaski County Council met in regular session Monday, April 12, 2021 8:20pm (Delayed because the Joint Session did not adjourn until 8:00pm) at the Pulaski County Highway Department training room. Councilmembers present were Ken Boswell, Ron DeSabatine, Mike Tiede, Kathleen Thompson, Brian Young, Adam Loehmer, and Tim Overmyer with County Auditor Laura Wheeler.

Also present were Gail Lambert, Connie Ehrlich, Joe Calabrese, Crystal Kocher, Brandon DeLorenzo, Kyle McIntyre, Autumn Bailor, Stephanie Foust, Nathan Origer, Mary Welker, and Jeff Richwine.

IN RE: EMS

Brandon DeLorenzo presented spreadsheets on the 2021 Salary Matrix for EMS, starting with the current MATRIX, which has a 24-hours-on/48-hours-off schedule. He proposes the first two raises for longevity come sooner, raise the percentage of the Advanced EMT to promote basics to advance their career and level raises across the certification levels and years of service so they are the same. He also suggests that part-time rates be a percentage of department head pay. The proposed changes will increase the payroll budget by almost \$60,000.00. A 12-hour shift MATRIX also discussed.

Other aspects of Emergency Medical Service discussed.

Michael T. Tiede motioned to move forward with the suggested MATRIX changes, Ronald DeSabatine seconded. Motion carried 5-1 with Kathleen Thompson opposed.
