

**MAY 9, 2022**

**REGULAR SESSION**

**PULASKI COUNTY COUNCIL**

The Pulaski County Council met in regular session Monday May 9, 2022 7:00pm at the Pulaski County Highway Garage training room. Councilmembers present were Ken Boswell, Adam Loehmer, Mike Tiede, Kathi Thompson, Brian Young, and Tim Overmyer with County Auditor Laura Wheeler. Councilmember Ron DeSabatine was absent.

Also present were Maurice Loehmer, Terri Hansen, Teresa Bryant, and Nathan Origer.

President Boswell opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**IN RE: TREASURER**

The Cumulative Jail \$200,000.00, 6-month CD is up for renewal. Council plans to fund the work release program with this money. Adam Loehmer motioned to renew the CD for \$200,000.00 for another six month period. Michael T. Tiede seconded and motion carried unanimously.

**IN RE: PARKING LOTS**

Three quotes received for the parking lots west of the Justice Center as follows:

Town & Country Paving	55,000.00
E&B Paving	62,818.00
Central Paving	63,615.00

The Town of Winamac has already approved the sidewalks and will provide the lighting. Questions concerning the work included in the quotes addressed. Kathleen Thompson made a motion to approve \$65,000.00 for advertising from Riverboat to cover the cost of this project. Discussion followed. Brian Young seconded the motion and motion carried unanimously.

**IN RE: EMS**

Grant for purchase of new ambulance will only provide 35% of the needed funding. After considerable discussion Kathleen Thompson made a motion to support the grant application and to fund 65% of the purchase price, Brian Young seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Kathleen Thompson made a motion to approve the following transfer requests, Michael T. Tiede seconded and motion carried unanimously.

The Health Department received special funding from the Indiana Department of Health and needs to appropriate this money before spending. Kathleen Thompson motioned to approve \$25,000.00 additional for advertising from fund 8912, Michael T. Tiede seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Kathleen Thompson made a motion to approve and sign April 11, 2022 regular session minutes as presented, Michael T. Tiede seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Budget hearings set for August 8 & 9, 2022 from 9:00am to 4:00pm discussed briefly. Kathleen Thompson made a motion to set a 5% pay raise cap for department budgets, Adam Loehmer seconded. Motion passed 4-2 in favor with Brian Young, Adam Loehmer, Kathleen Thompson, and Kenneth Boswell in favor; Michael T. Tiede and Tim Overmyer opposed.

With no other business to discuss, meeting was adjourned at 7:56 PM.
