WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners and Pulaski County Council have determined that a stop sign needs to be placed at each of the following intersections: 1.)500 North and 300 West; and 2.) 200 North and 300 West.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Pulaski County and the Pulaski County Council that after the erection of appropriate STOP signs all traffic shall be required to stop at the intersection of 500 North and 300 West; and 200 North and 300 West. The effect of this ordinance shall be to cause traffic coming from any direction to stop and to proceed only at such time as it is safe and clear to do so.
