Roth, Alexsondra Haschel. The Pulaski County Commissioner said meeting called to order by Larry L. Brady, President, and other Commissioner Tracey Shorter, Vice-President and Terry L. Young, and Shelia K. Garling, Auditor.

IN RE: COUNTY HOME REFRIDGERATOR

Larry L. Brady mentioned that the refrigerator had quite working and a new one was needed at the County Home. Motion made by Tracey Shorter to purchase a refrigerator at the county home. Seconded by Terry L. Young. Motion carried.

IN RE: CONFERENCE APPROVAL

Larry L. Brady is requesting to attend the Indiana Association of County Commissioners District meeting on June 11, 2014 in Plymouth IN. Motion made by Tracey Shorter for Larry to attend Commissioners meeting on Wednesday at Plymouth. Seconded by Terry L Young. Motion carried.

IN RE: INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF SOLID WASTE DISTRICT

Larry L. Brady talked about the Solid Waste Meeting; they were talking about the solid waste district budget. They are going to eliminate the grant money for towns and school for this year. Our Recycling Center receives 22,000.00 and 20,000.00 they are eliminating 10,000.00 of the 20,000.00. They cut 120,000.00 from the total grant money they usually give out.

Discussion of getting ready for budgets, what to look for and what is really needed. The departments do a very good job with the budgets and the Council is able to work with them.

The military vehicles that we are acquiring will come out of the Commissioners budget regarding insurance. We have about 25 that are license plated and insured. The rest will be added at the beginning of the year. Do we have an inventory list of all the military vehicles? Discussion was no. The County Council made a request to the sheriff for a list of military vehicles that we currently have.

Terry L. Young will return a call tomorrow to see where we stand on this.

IN RE: INCREASE OF PAY FOR TINA KASTEN, COUNTY HOME

At this time we are not going to change Tina Kasten's hourly rate. This could be brought up again during budgets.

IN RE: COMMENT

Roger Querry wants to set down with every employee that works for the County at the beginning of January and go through all the cost that the county pays for each employee with PERF and insurance.

IN RE: AIRPORT INFORMATION

This came up because we received a bill from Novotny's for Do we need to make Francis (Bud) Widner a full time county employee, do we need someone out there to put gas in the plane. Does it need to have someone out there? The committee met but no decisions were made. Are we obligated to have the airport opened? Are we mandated to have an airport?

IN RE: BUILDING INSPECTOR ASSISTANT FULL TIME

A question regarding the Building Inspector assistant going full time. At this time they will not make him full time. The Building Inspector assistant went out in the field and questioned a taxpayer about a building being torn down. Is he supposed to be out in the field? There is no full time position, and there is no money appropriated in the budget. The budgets are coming up, that's when you plead your case.

IN RE: IT PERSONNEL

Is our IT needs being taken care of? Willie DeGroot is taking care of all our computer needs. Tracey Shorter commented that Kevin Tankersley had looked at all the time that DeGroot Technology has been doing our repairs and didn't find that we needed a full time IT person. So the discussion will be to contract this service out.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:02 p.m., Eastern Savings Time. A motion to adjourn by Terry L. Young. Seconded by Tracey Shorter. Motion carried.
